Year 10 Careers Information Meetings with Youth Connexions in March.

On either 3.3.16, 7.3.16 or 14.3.16 Y10 students will receive a one-to-one careers meeting with a personal advisor from Youth Connexions. Each student will receive an individual appointment slot for 30 minutes allocated to one of the four personal advisors coming into school to deliver careers information advice and guidance.

Key Stage 4 is the right time for students to research and develop their understanding of the changing world of work, the education and training pathways available and gain employability skills. Students will make important decisions about the next stage of their education, employment or training. It is crucial that students are aware of all the options open to them, receive impartial guidance to enable them to make informed and realistic decisions and the encouragement to take responsibility for their own futures.

Youth Connexions Information, Advice and Guidance Practitioners will be in Haileybury Turnford to meet with Y10 students in March.

The key outcomes of the interview will be that students will be able to:

- · Understand all the post 16 pathways available to them
- · Investigate the range of opportunities available, enabling an informed, logical process for choosing future courses
- · Access a wide range of labour market information and intelligence
- · Understand how to make effective applications, including registering and applying for apprenticeships
- Draw up an action plan identifying and setting SMART targets, identifying strengths and areas for development and including back up plans.
