Students will gain their qualifications whilst earning a generous salary and benefits package, and there are no tuition fees.

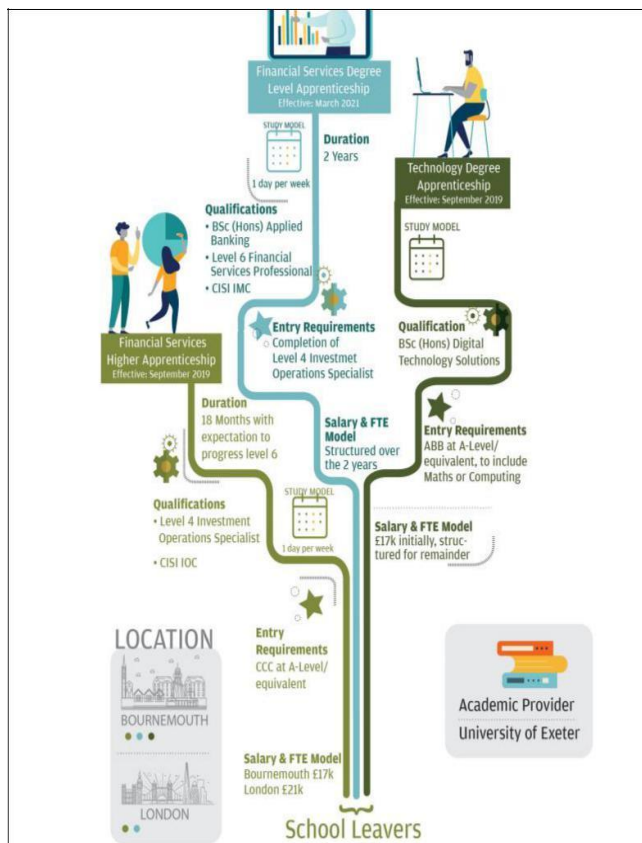
