As expected there are many ways you can support your son or daughter to apply for an apprenticeship. Encourage your child to start to build a portfolio of experience and not just collect the brochures to use quickly based on job type.

None of the good jobs have been snapped up already! Although it is true that many of the most popular apprenticeships are filled, there are still thousands of other roles available to apply for. If your child is interested in applying for an apprenticeship, my advice is to follow these steps:

1. Register on Find an Apprenticeship! The Government's new website lists an Apprenticeship Skills Register of current vacancies. <https://www.findanapprenticeship.gov.uk/>
2. Start researching. Start applying for vacancies that take your interest. Always apply for more than one and remember to tailor your application to each position that you are applying for.

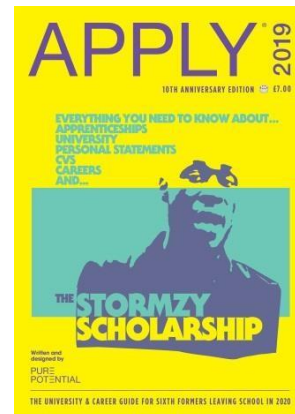
