Dear Parent/Carer

Haileybury Turnford will be taking part in this year's Christmas Jumper Day on Friday 14th December. This is to raise money for the charity Save the Children, did you know that with just £2 they can provide antibiotics for 5 children with pneumonia. By wearing our Christmas jumpers and donating, we will change the lives of these children.

All children and staff are invited to wear their Christmas jumpers on **Friday 14th December**. We'd like everyone to take part so please encourage your child to come into school on the day wearing their Christmas jumper and suitable for school additional clothing and with a £1 donation. The following dress code will be applicable for Friday 14th December:

- Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times
- The standard of dress is to be tidy, casual clothing
- Any student is free to wear normal school uniform

Examples of inappropriate clothing:

- Mini-skirts or very short non tailored skirts
- Clothing displaying offensive logos, drug, alcohol or tobacco-related slogans
- Flip-flops or very high heels
- Very short and revealing tops
- No body art, for example henna, unless connected to cultural traditions
- No false nails are to be worn.

If a student arrives to school in clothing, we consider in our opinion to be inappropriate for a school environment then they should expect to be challenged. Parents will be contacted to bring a change of clothes and if this is not possible, students will work in the Internal Isolation room for the day.

In addition to this Year 7 students will be hosting a Christmas themed bake sale during break and lunchtime on the day, all items will cost 50p, should students wish to further support the charity by buying some cake.
