Dear Parent/Carer

A very warm welcome to the new school year and I hope you had a very pleasant summer, enjoying our hottest weather in many years!

I am proud of the improvements we have made to the quality of education at Haileybury Turnford in the past two years, and would like to thank you for your support in helping this to happen. As communicated before the summer holidays, we will be having a new building to replace our existing English and Humanities, and our small Science Blocks. This project is as a result of successfully gaining access to the Education & Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) Priority Schools Building Programme. I will continue to keep you informed as we go through this academic year. We expect to complete this project by September 2020.

A further exciting initiative this term will be with Twofour Broadcast Limited who will be working with us to produce a brand new factual series for Channel 4. The series will consist of four episodes, and each hour long episode will feature a different school following the daily life of a new volunteer member of the school support staff working with Year 11 students. This is an excellent opportunity for us, and will showcase how the deployment of support staff can result in positive outcomes for students. Further information will follow in the next few weeks.

We had very successful GCSE, A Level and vocational exam results in August. On A Level results day it was excellent to see our sixth formers achieving the results to enable them to move onto their chosen university choices, higher level apprenticeships or work. We also had our first ever student being accepted into the University of Cambridge. On GCSE results day we sustained last year's significant improvements in GCSE English and Maths results and now have our largest Year 12 cohort since Haileybury Turnford opened.
