

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
The rule is simple: phones are off and out of sight or your mobile phone will be confiscated.

Good attendance and punctuality improves chances of success

- Good attendance and punctuality are essential if you are to achieve your full potential, both academically and socially.
- You must arrive before 8.30am
- The main school gates will be locked at 8.30am
- If you arrive after 8.30am will be marked in as Late and will be issued with a late payback (detention)
- Registration starts at 8.35am
- · You will attend a payback with a Year Achievement Coordinator on the same day at break time.
- Failure to attend this payback will result in further consequences.
- Repeated late attendance to school will be treated very seriously and if you are repeatedly late to school without a valid reason your parents will receive a letter warning about the legal consequences of persistent lateness. Persistent lateness to school will result in parents/carers being warned and then issued with Fixed Penalty Notices involving a fine.

Red Card	Serious breach of the behaviour code. Removal into the Reflection Centre. Parents informed.	6 behaviour points


