Dear Parents/Carers

#### Year 10

Firstly, I hope that you have all had an enjoyable summer and I would like to welcome you and your child to Haileybury Turnford this year. I am delighted to be the students' Year Achievement Coordinator and look forward to overseeing their progression this year. On Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> September at 5.00pm we would like to welcome all Year 10 Parents/Carers to attend a Key to Success meeting at Haileybury Turnford. This meeting will be an important opportunity to meet with a number of key members of staff. As it is the start of the new academic year, I am writing to remind you of some of our procedures and inform you of some changes.

If you would like to discuss any issues relating to your son/daughter, the first point of contact must be made through their tutor. I have listed below tutors and tutor groups and have included their email addresses for you.

If you wish to see your child's tutor or a member of staff, you will need to contact reception on (01992) 308333 and make an appointment. All staff have teaching commitments and will not be available unless an appointment has been made.

#### **Attendance**

Students should aim for 100% attendance. As a parent/carer you can monitor your child's attendance and punctuality by accessing the Insight website. If your child is unwell and not fit to attend school please ensure you ring the school's absence number on **01992 308333 option 1**, alternatively send an email to <a href="mailto:attendance@haileyburyturnford.com">attendance@haileyburyturnford.com</a> you can also log the absence on Insight. Please notify us of your child's absence on the first day, we then ask you to keep us informed of their progress and provide medical notes from a GP if your child requires more than 4 days away from school due to illness. Students falling below 90% attendance in the preceding 6 weeks and ten or more unauthorised absences could well be subject to Education External Agencies involvement and awarded a Fixed Penalty Notice.

Any absence means that your child will miss out on work, fall behind and perhaps miss important deadlines. Students need to catch up on any work missed. I urge you **not** to take your child out of school for holidays or for appointments where possible. Please try and ensure that if your child needs to be absent from school for a medical appointment, they do not lose a whole school day for this appointment. Your child should return to school following the appointment if at all possible.





### **Punctuality**

Students need to arrive at school promptly for registration at 8:35am. I suggest that they arrive no later than 8:25am. The gate will close at 8.30am. Late arrivals are monitored and students who arrive late in the morning will receive a same day break time payback. Repeated lates will mean the student will receive a 1 or 2-hour payback with a Senior Leader.

## **Uniform Expectations**

Students must wear their blazers and their shirts must be tucked in. In addition, students' top buttons must be done up. Boys must wear their ties at all times. Girls must have the Haileybury Turnford skirt (or trousers) and this should fall two inches below the knee. The grey Haileybury Turnford jumper is optional until October half-term. After half-term all students will be expected to wear to grey Haileybury Turnford jumper. Trainers should not be worn to and from school and students need to wear black leather/leather-look shoes. Canvas shoes are not permitted. If female students choose to wear trousers they must have the Haileybury Turnford logo. Students must only wear one earring per ear and these must be either a plain gold or silver stud. As the colder weather approaches, please ensure your child wears a suitable jacket or coat. Hair styles must be suitable for school and hair should be natural in colour. Please can we remind all parents and carers that nail varnish, acrylic nails and gel nails are not permitted. In addition, students are not allowed to wear false eyelashes. If a student is found to be not wearing the correct uniform, the student can expect to receive a sanction. Thank you for your support in maintaining our uniform expectations.

#### **Student Planners**

Student planners have been issued to all students and I would be grateful if you would spend a few minutes looking through these with your child. Planners should be signed by parents/carers on a weekly basis.

#### Prep

Prep (homework) will be set this using an online system called Class Charts. Students and parents will receive a personal user code in the next few days. Students will also be expected to keep a written record of any Prep in their Planners. Please can we ask all Parents/Carers to regularly check and sign student Planners on a weekly basis, if you have any queries or concerns regarding your child's Prep, please do not hesitate to contact your child's Tutor.

# **Insight Parent Portal**

The Parent Portal enables you to see lots of up to date information about your son or daughter. This includes your son or daughter's timetable and teachers, up to date attendance information including lesson by lesson attendance.

## **Cycling to School**

Due to a number of cycling related incidents in Cheshunt and Turnford, the busy main road near to our school and our responsibility to safeguard and protect our students, we are planning to introduce an expectation that every student riding a bike to school will need to wear a cycle helmet. Therefore, please make sure your child has a helmet that fits correctly and can be stored safely with the bike in the bike shed. (Most cycle locks can be threaded through the holes in the cycle helmet). If your child does not wear the helmet, we will be locking their bike securely and asking for either you to collect their bike or bring in a cycle helmet, before the bike is released.
