Q1	I enjoy my lessons and find the work interesting	94%
Q2	I feel well supported in my learning	96%
Q3	I am encouraged to challenge myself in lessons	96%
Q4	The prep (homework) I am given helps me to learn	71%
Q5	I understand the rules and the minimum expectations of being Ready, Respectful and Safe	95%
Q6	I have started to settle in well	98%
Q7	I feel that I have good relations with the school	96%
Q8	Resources and support provided in lessons have been well-matched to my ability	96%
Q9	I receive encouraging comments from staff when I do well	86%
Q10	All the teachers give out Achievement Points equally	79%
