Enrichment for a broad and well-rounded student experience



We attend University and Apprenticeship Fairs and run a Futures Week where we help to prepare our students for life after Haileybury Turnford and hear about the vast range of courses and training available. Students find these events helpful and inspiring as they begin to decide their next steps after Sixth Form.

Alongside the suite of A level subjects, we also offer the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ). This is a standalone qualification designed to extend and develop your skills in independent research and project management and is recognised by universities and employers.

Students are also able to participate in the Employability Skills programme run by Young Enterprise, giving practical help on CV writing, job applications and interview skills, as well as starting up a business and managing money.



As well as your academic or vocational studies, our Sixth Form gives you space to further your potential and grow in confidence.

We participate in several enrichment programmes and encourage students to explore all that is available. Anyone interested in developing their personal interests, skills and experiences is given the support and assurance they need to pursue their goals.

Very recently, one of our Sixth Form students won the prestigious Pioneer Award from BASET (Britain-Australia Society Education Trust) which allowed her to travel to Australia to spend a month at Haileybury Melbourne.

We regularly have speakers from universities to come to our Sixth Form to give students an understanding of the university experience. We also invite organisations, such as the Bank of England, to discuss what the bank does and how the economy works.

Students can also have the opportunity to work with local business mentors through our participation in the Dragons' Apprentice Challenge. This annual contest sees over 100 ambitious students from the Broxbourne and East Herts area compete to increase funds for a start-up with the help of a 'Dragon'. Competition is strong, and our students always work hard to achieve their goals.
