Enrichment week

We are writing to inform you that, as part of Enrichment week, on Wednesday 17th July Year 10 will participate in a day of activities within Lee Valley Regional Park.

What is the aim of this day?

The aim of this day is for all Year 10 students to develop their enquiry skills through learning about key features of their local area. Students will be given a series of challenges and work through a number of activities to spark their curiosity and aid their geographical understanding of the local area.

What will happen on the day?

- Students will need to attend school at normal time.
- We will enter Lee Valley Park by Turnford Brook and walk to the White Water Centre.
- We will return to school for the end of the school day at 3.00pm.
- Students can attend this trip in non-uniform, as long as they are dressed appropriately to represent the school. Please be advised that whatever the weather students will be outdoors all day and therefore sun cream/waterproofs etc. may be required on the day.
- Students will need to wear suitable walking shoes e.g. trainers.
- Students will be required to bring a pen and pencil, along with a packed lunch for the day. A small amount of money may be advisable for extra drinks but is not a necessity.

It is our expectation that all students will participate in this day. If for any reason your child is not able to do so please contact us by email, no later than Friday 5th July so that we can make alternative arrangements for your child to stay in school.
