YPLA Bursary fund application form guidance 2019/2020

Notes:

- 1. The guaranteed bursary (£1200 per year) is intended to support those students in the following categories
 - Students in receipt of Income Support or Universal Credit
 - Students who are care leavers
 - Students who are in care
 - **Students** who are disabled and in receipt of either Personal Independence Payments or Disability Living Allowance

Any student not in one of the 4 categories above is unable to apply for the guaranteed bursary but could still be entitled to the discretionary bursary

- 2. The **discretionary** bursary is intended to support students facing financial hardship and whose family income is below the threshold of £25,000 with school course-related costs Evidence of circumstances to confirm eligibility include:
 - Student is eligible for free school meals now or was in year 11
 - Students living in a household where the parent(s)/guardian(s)are in receipt of income support / housing benefit
 - Students living in a household where the gross annual household income is less than £25,000

Evidence of eligibility is required before any payment is authorised and could include a Housing association letter, your P45 from the 2018/2019 year or any other valid documentation to prove circumstances.

Bursaries will be paid by cheque, monthly in arrears, and all students will be required to meet the standards of attendance and behaviour as laid out in the expectations document.
