



Intervention: Extended Work Experience **Placement x3 days per week**

Short description: The strategy aims to improve motivation, attendance, future aspiration and minimise risk of exclusion and risk associated behaviour.

Intended measure: Reduction in the number of Fixed Term Exclusions, increase attendance to at least 96%, reduce risk of anti-social behaviour, improve future aspiration.

PP strategy evaluation

- 80% reduction in the number of Fixed Term Exclusions received in comparison to the previous year.
- Attendance remained at 76% (overall) although attendance to school improved to 96%
- Successful completion of all GCSE examinations and coursework entries
- Successful in achieving at least a Grade in all GCSE examinations
- Achieved a Level 1 Certificate in Functional Maths and English
- Successful post-16 placement at a college of higher education
- Achieved Level 1 in Vehicle Assistance and Maintenance (City & Guilds)

Intervention: TLC Live online 1-1 tutoring for Maths GCSE

Short description: 1-1 online Tutoring for Maths GCSE received over a period of 10 weeks.
