In helicopters, Airbus provides the most efficient civil and military rotorcraft solutions worldwide.

Being a Technical Apprentice at Airbus Defence & Space means you will get to develop both mechanical and electrical skills within the three year programme. You will be immersed in a stimulating manufacturing environment based at either our Farnborough, Portsmouth or Stevenage sites. Over the course of the apprenticeship, you will study towards a minimum of BTEC L3 and a maximum of HNC L4 level, depending on your prior educational attainment.

During the first year, you will gain both academic knowledge and practical experience. For years two and three, you will be on a day-release programme which is structured to give you a unique chance to experience different areas of the business and provide you with a comprehensive understanding of how Airbus Defence & Space works. - Panel structure build involving composite techniques and carbon fibre filament winding

- Material treatments including grit blasting of metallic items before application of corrosion inhibiting primers and paints.

- Passion for engineering, which you will be able to demonstrate through your educational choices or hobbies. For example, you may have been part of an engineering club at school or perhaps you enjoy fixing mechanical and electrical things in your spare time.

Charles Russell Speechlys is working with Cilex Law School and The City Law School at City, University of London to deliver the Solicitor Apprenticeship Programme

Whilst you will be working in our London offices for four days a week, one day each week will be allocated to study where you will often be required to attend classes at The City Law School, a 15 minute walk from our London office.

During the first four years of your apprenticeship you will study towards an LLB in Legal Practice, on completion of which you will be awarded a law degree. This course will also prepare you for the first set of the Solicitors Regulation Authority exams that you have to pass in order to become a solicitor.

For the last two years of your apprenticeship you will study the subjects and professional skills required to practise as a solicitor. The course will also prepare you for the second set of the Solicitors Regulation Authority assessments, which are practical legal skills assessments.

In line with the Solicitors Regulation Authority (SRA) requirements, you will sit the functional legal knowledge tests after year 4. These will be computer based central assessments and The City Law School will provide you with an intensive revision programme for this during your fourth year. You will be required to pass these exams before you can progress onto the practical legal skills assessments.



The subjects that you will cover in year's 5 and 6 at The City Law School will prepare you for this final exam at the end of the six years. You will be required to pass this exam before you can qualify as a solicitor.

Ashurst Solicitor Apprenticeship

- The assessment for the apprenticeship comprises coursework, exams and a portfolio of evidence to show you have met the competency framework for a junior lawyer.

The firm pays your study fees.

Entry requirements

To qualify you need a minimum of ABB at A-level or equivalent (obtained or predicted), as well as 7 GCSEs at A*-C (or 9-4 for the numbered GCSE grading system).

You don't need to study law to apply.

The recruitment process includes:

- an online application
- online cognitive ability tests
- a 20-30 minute phone interview with HR
- a short assessment centre, including a written case study, interview with our team, and a tour of the office
