RE: Year 12 & 13 CPLD trip to the Museum of Childhood, Bethnal Green

A trip to the **V&A Museum of Childhood, Bethnal Green** has been organised for all students studying BTEC CPLD on **Monday 10th February 2020**. The trip will include free-time to walk around the museum looking at the current exhibits and a 45 minute teaching session at 1.00pm, after this we will return. This trip has been organised to enhance the learning within the BTEC CPLD qualification and will directly support the work in unit 3 Play and Learning.

I will meet students after morning registration at 8.55am in SM3, we will then walk to Cheshunt train station where we will catch the train directly from Cheshunt to Cambridge Heath station. We will then walk the short distance to the museum. There is a café, toilets and picnic area at the museum. Returning to school, we will walk back to Cambridge Heath station and catch a train back to Cheshunt, from there with parent permission (on the reply slip at the bottom of this letter) students will be free to make their own way home, or they may walk back to school with myself, we aim to be back at school by 3.00pm.

The total cost of this trip is £15.00 (this covers the train tickets and teaching session at the museum) and payment must be made via ParentPay by Wednesday 22nd January 2020.

Students will be out of lessons all day and therefore will require a healthy packed lunch (or some money to buy lunch at the museum café) and plenty of water. Students are representing Haileybury Turnford and must wear professional clothing as they would to school.
