Dear Parent/Carer

RE: Year 12 & 13 Business & Economics trip to the Bank of England Museum.

Your son/daughter has been invited to a trip to the Bank of England museum, London on the 26<sup>th</sup> March 2020. This is an exciting opportunity for your child to be introduced to what the Bank of England is and the role it plays in our economy to broaden their understanding beyond the classroom. The day will involve students touring the museum, where they can discover, history, architecture and how bank notes were designed as well as exhibitions that are on during this month and much more. In addition, included in the day is private presentation for our students on what the Bank of England does, why low inflation and stable systems matter.

Students will be travelling by coach to and from the school which will depart the school at 10.00am prompt. We will depart the museum to return back to school at 3.30pm with an approximate time of return to school of 5.00pm. We have planned to have lunch before going into the museum, therefore, if students wish to, they may have lunch at Gourmet Burger Kitchen on arrival which is a 12minutes walk from the museum or students can bring a packed lunch as their lunch cost will not be covered by the school. All student that are entitled to a free school meal, will be provided a school packed lunch on arrival.

Students will not need to wear school uniform on this trip but need to be dressed appropriately. They should wear their lanyards at all times. We have high expectations of student behaviour on trips. The School reserves the right to withdraw a student from the trip if their behaviour in school means that they could not be trusted or would be likely to undermine the safety or success of trip for others.

There will be no museum entry or travel cost for your child to pay as this will be covered by the school. However, we will need consent from you to confirm your child's attendance on this trip by Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February.
