

Schools Students are a Class act

A-level results achieved by Haileybury Turnford students have placed the school in the top 25% of schools nationally for progress



The figures, recently published by the Department of Education, show the school's Progress Score for A-level Performance in summer 2019 at +0.16 – **the best figure among similar schools in the local area.**

“We are delighted with what the performance tables show – both an improvement in performance compared to 2018 and an excellent performance compared to other Hertfordshire schools, both locally and further afield” said Principal Robin Newman.

The score ranks Haileybury Turnford 16th for academies and maintained schools across Hertfordshire and 28th out of all 128 providers including independent schools.

Progress Scores for Haileybury Turnford students re-sitting English and Maths were also well above Hertfordshire and national levels and students completing Applied General qualifications achieved in line with national expectations too, meaning that students on all courses in Haileybury Turnford's sixth form performed strongly.

“This is further evidence of the high-quality education we are able to provide in our Sixth Form, with opportunities to progress to a wide range of destinations beyond Year 13,” Mr Newman added.

Navpreet Shivalkar, Head of Sixth Form said “Due to the significant hard work made by both students and staff, we continue to make real improvements to our sixth form provision, already judged Good by Ofsted in May 2018. We are able to provide real quality post-16 provision for students in the local area.”
