Haileybury Turnford joins The Big Legal Lesson during Justice Week

As part of Justice Week 2020 (24th – 28thFebruary), the students at Haileybury Turnford led by the Haileybury Turnford Debating Committee will join tens of thousands of young people across schools in England and Wales to benefit from <u>'The Big Legal Lesson'</u>. This schools' campaign, led by the education charity Young Citizens, is expected to be the biggest public legal education event of its kind as it introduces the fundamentals of the Justice system in England and Wales.
