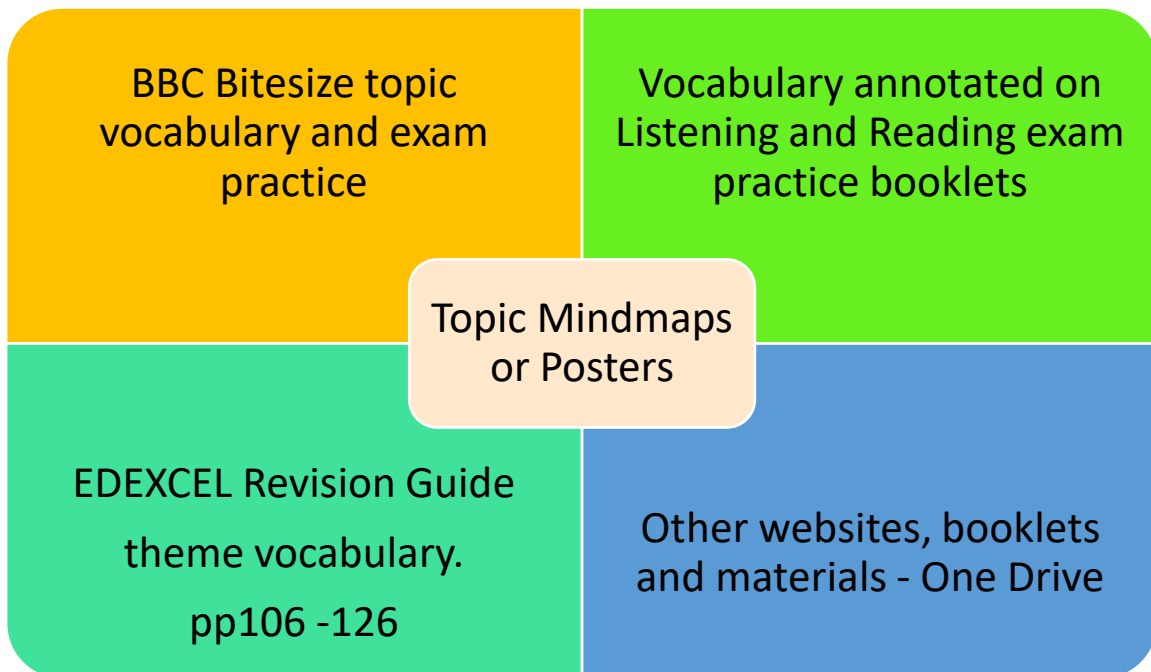
Know your 7 tenses

1. Know them for regular AR, ER and IR verbs
2. Know them for irregular important verbs (SER, TENER, IR, HACER, PODER)
3. Know your extras: the subjunctive - si fuera..., me gustaría.... And the pluperfect – había hecho..

Use **BBC Bitesize to organise your topic order.** (Higher candidates may want to start from the bottom up. Those are the harder topics (Future Aspirations and International/Global).

Date	Topic and actions - 3 x 1 hour each week!
Week 1: March 17 th 2020	Irregular verbs in 7 tenses – flash cards (use for the below) Role play practice – use your booklet Practice question words (Guide p110) Photo task practice – use your booklet Practice sentence starters and verbs to go with them. Remember: description, opinion, past tense, future tense, opinion! FOCUS: Random theme questions – make sure you have at least three per theme memorised. (Most of you had your speech & post-speech questions done already. Practice these a bit.)
Week 2: March 23 rd	Random theme questions – PERFECT THEM! Go over photo task sentence starters and verb tenses! Know these! Pick 10 nouns to know for each of: places in town, sports, foods, activities, clothing, celebrations. F - Pick 15 adjectives to know. H – Pick 25 adjectives to know.
Week 3: March 30 th	ACTUAL Speaking Exam Continue 1 x 3 hours on the above, if exam is rescheduled.
Week 4: April 6 th	BBC Bitesize – Who am I? – go through all vocabulary, reading and listening- do all practice activities. Then go through all practice exams and pull out vocabulary/verbs to do with this topic. Finally, briefly over theme vocabulary in revision guide. Topic – Me, my family and friends – x1.5 hours Topic – My interests and role models – x1.5 hours
Week 5: April 13 th	BBC Bitesize –Daily Life – go through all vocabulary, reading and listening- do all practice activities. Then go through all practice exams and pull out vocabulary/verbs to do with this topic. Finally, briefly revise theme vocabulary in Revision Guide. Topic – Social media and technology –45 minutes Topic – Everyday life at home –1.5 hrs Topic Food and eating out - 45 minutes
