Teachers will upload work daily so students should check Classcharts regularly.



From here you can access materials without creating a log in, however if you create a login the site will 'mark' answers and keep a log of your results, helping direct you to areas you need to focus on.






If you wish to sign up, click in the top right-hand corner and a sign-up box will appear (see opposite.). Once you have completed the sign-up page using your Haileybury Turnford account, it will ask whether you are a student or a teacher. It will then ask for the school's name.

To get Premium services, you would need to pay, however the free resources are excellent and provide plenty of detail and information to use alongside other materials provided by your teachers.

Once you have accessed the front page you can select the relevant filters to search for learning support materials.
