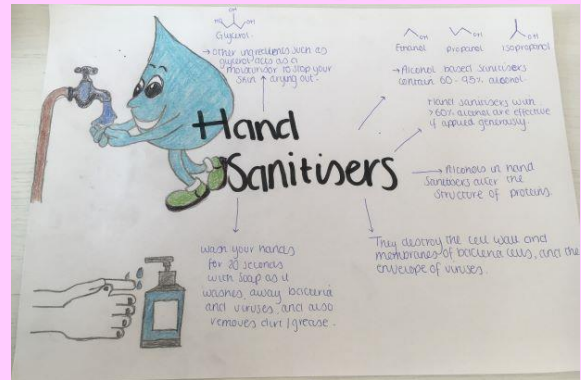

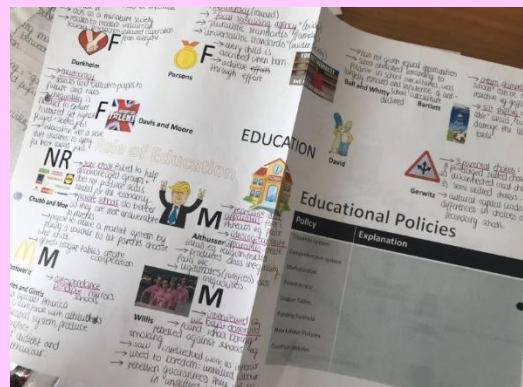

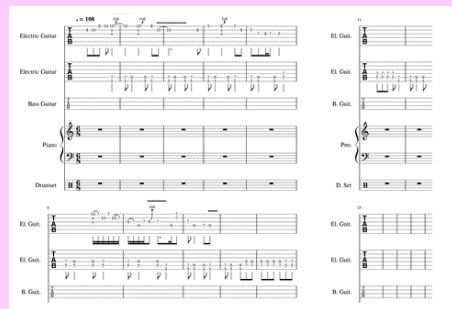

6. Explain why you did not choose one of the other three options.

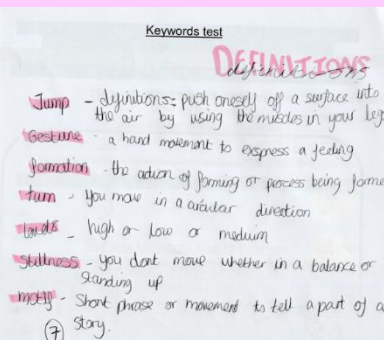

Inspirational person no.3: Well known hero Rosa Parks

Rosa Parks was born Rosa Louise McCauley on February 4th 1913 in Tuskegee, Alabama, United States to Leona and James McCauley. Her mother was a teacher and her father a carpenter. When Rosa was young her parents separated and she went to live her grandparents on a farm with her mother and younger brother Sylvester. When Rosa got older she dropped out of school to look after her grandmother and mother after they became ill. She grew up in a time of racial segregation that was imposed in public facilities and retail stores in the South, this included public transportation. Buses and trains had a policy with separate sections for blacks and whites. Growing up in a world of racism and seeing the Ku Klux Klan march down the street she lived in was daily life for her. Rosa married and took on many jobs, also becoming active in the civil rights movement. Many years later after a hard days work, Rosa took the bus home and sat in the section marked 'coloured' of the bus. As the bus filled with white people the bus driver moved the notice to behind where Rosa was sitting. This meant that any black persons sitting were to get up and give that seat to a white person. Rosa refused to move and was arrested. Her arrest was started plans for the Montgomery bus boycott. The boycott went on for over 381 days and buses stood idle for months and these businesses started to decline. This single act (although not intentional) started a change in segregation. In her later years, Rosa would see all her family around her pass away. She wrote her autobiography, which recounts her life leading to her decision to keep her seat on the bus. What could I learn about this lady? That sometimes in life people will try to boss you around and you must stand up for what you think is right and what you believe in.
