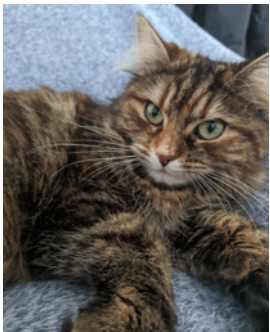

1. Observant, helpful & generous


2. Observant: "A little girl is standing there in the square below. She is selling eggs. Her eggs have fallen onto the ground."
