with pen pen wedges

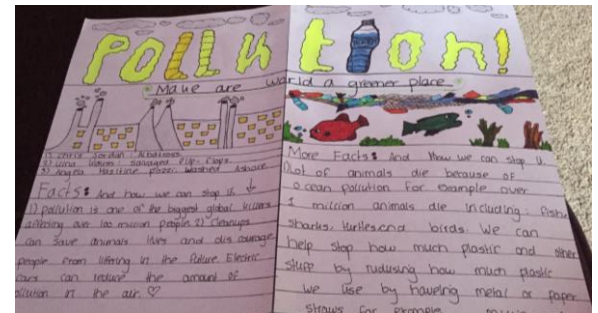


1 large onion - China - 4631m

Ground Turmeric - India - 4683m  
Tomatoes - Mexico - 5280m  
Whole milk - USA - 5280m  
Paprika - Argentina - 507161m  
Salt - The Netherlands - 275m  
Chicken Breast - Brazil - 6559m  
Vegetable oil - Indonesia - 7314m  
Oregano - New Zealand - 11477m

Every ingredient can be grown or produced in the UK apart from turmeric. Unfortunately, this is a tropical plant so it cannot grow in an unheated space in the UK. You can substitute it for ginger, cumin or curry powder. I used cumin and paprika for more spice when I made the kebabs.
