

Year 12 Virtual Work Experience Tasks

Option 1

Students to sign up to www.insidesherpa.com they can then choose to experience virtual work experience programmes in the following areas:

- Law
- Technology
- Finance
- Accounting
- Consulting
- Marketing
- Media
- Social Impact
- Engineering

These take at least 6 hours to complete all of the tasks associated with these areas and there is a choice of up to 12 different virtual programmes in each category.

1. On the home page select Find a Virtual Work Experience program
2. Then register your details by selecting sign up with email
3. Where it says current university put in I'm still in High School
4. For current degree type in n/a
5. Use your school email address in the registration
6. When on your account page scroll down to see all the virtual work experience programs
7. When you have completed one take a screenshot of your home page to show the part on the right that has complete programs and your name at the top
8. Send this to your form tutor
