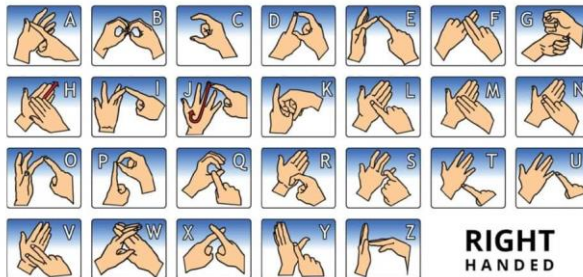
## A MESSAGE FROM MISS KAPOSÍ

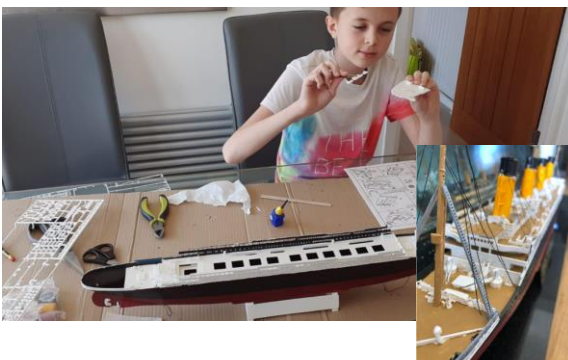

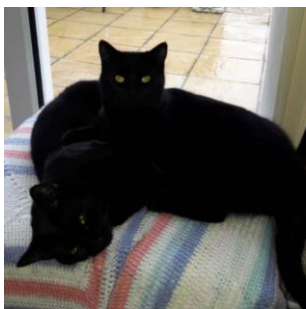

This is my video project to show one of the things that could be done to protect a tall building during an earthquake to prevent it from collapsing.

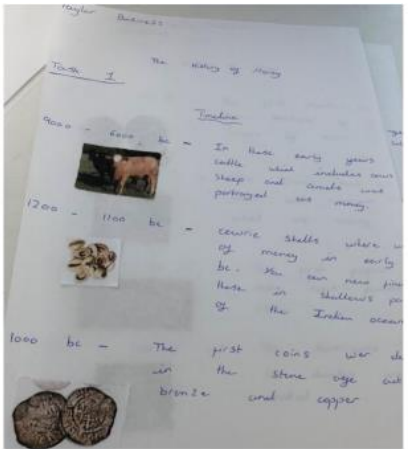
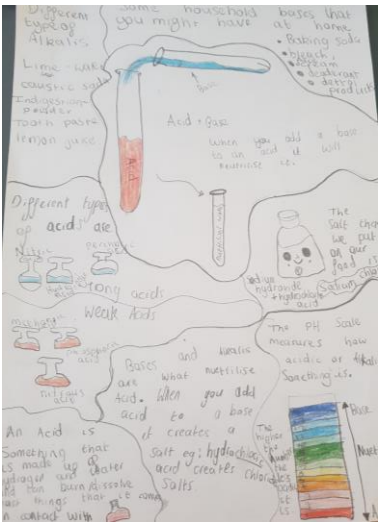
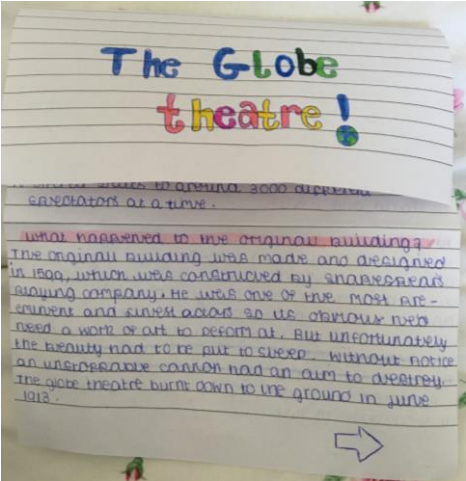
The video on the left has no protection were as the video on the right has a counterweight.

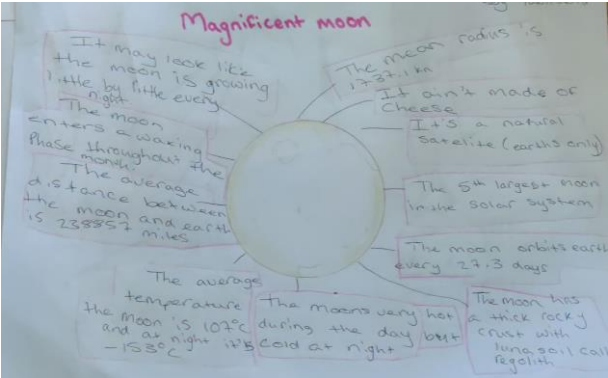

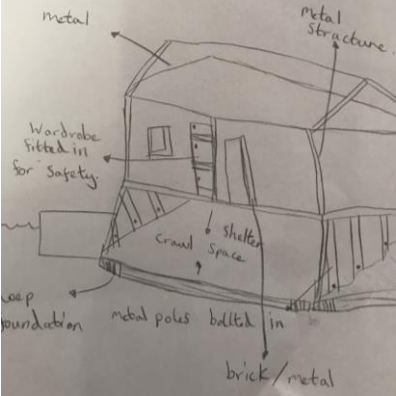
