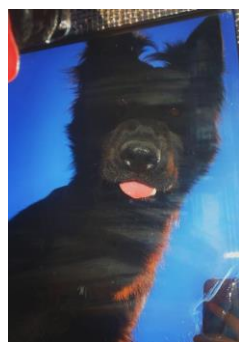

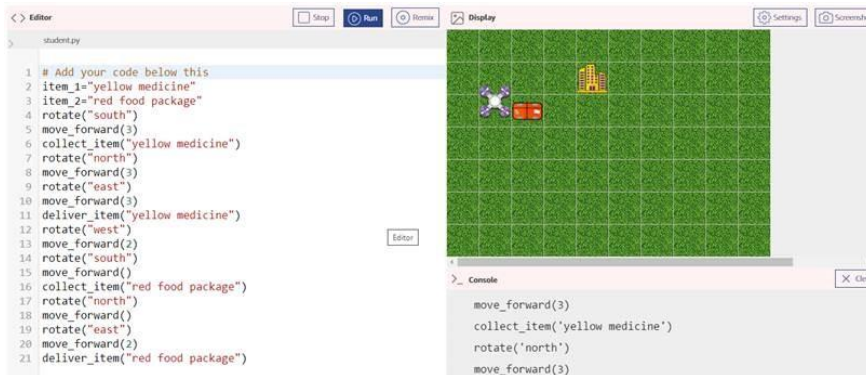




**Horror strikes small town**

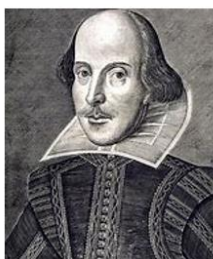

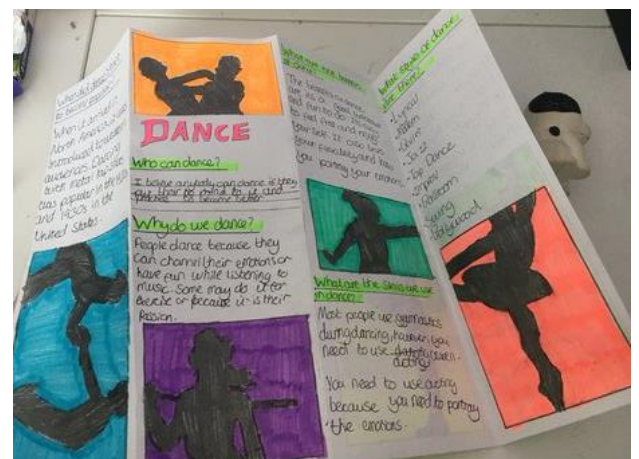


Food

Served with shortbread cookies, this pudding made an excellent Elizabethan dessert. Also, Warden Pies Made with brick hard pears, called Warden pears, these pies were open face tarts. They were often colored with spices to make the food bright, which was a Tudor era favorite.

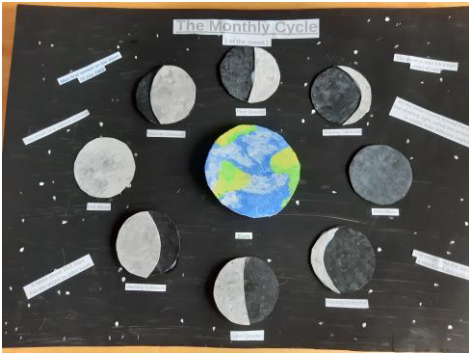
