Year 12 Higher Education Parents' Information Evening: Monday 13th July, 6.30pm - 7.30pm

I hope that you and your families are safe and well.

We know that despite the uncertainty that surrounds everyday life at the moment students should still be thinking about their futures after Sixth Form, and that as parents and carers you will have as many questions as the students themselves.

We have partnered with The University of Northampton, and will be hosting a **Parents Information Evening, Live, on Monday 13**th **July, 6.30pm – 7.30pm.** As part of the evening we will deliver a talk that introduces higher education, and gives an overview of the application process, student finance, and some key considerations when choosing a university and course. There will then be an opportunity to ask any questions that you or the students themselves may have.

- This session is specifically for Year 12 students and their parents or carers. If you are also a parent of a student in another Year group we will be happy to answer questions to also support them, but the talk itself will be relevant for students in Year 12 and their parents and carers.
