How long have you worked at the school? 1 Year

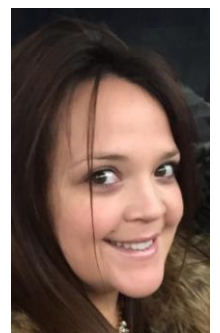
What are your interests? Reading, music and visiting places rich in History

- the context or impact of a work of literature i.e. A Boy in Striped Pyjamas, Of Mice and Men, Romeo and Juliet etc
- a scientific development i.e. Microplastics in the sea etc

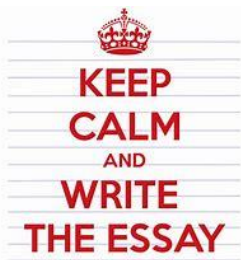
Entries will be judged on the quality of your research, engagement with the title, creativity of thought, accuracy of writing, and degree of challenge.

There will be three categories:

- **The KS3 Prize** (current Years 7, and 8) with a maximum word count of 600-800 words.
- **The KS4 Prize** (current Years 9 and 10) with a maximum word count of 1000 words.
- **The KS5 Prize** (current Year 11) with a maximum word count of 1500 words.

The deadline is **Monday 7th September**. Winners will be awarded in the Autumn term and the work published in newsletters, as well as being displayed in school.
