Dear Parent/Carer

I hope that you and your families are keeping well during this uncertain time. Over the last term, we have been setting our Year 7,8 & 9 students project work through Class Charts. This has been extremely successful and our teachers are overwhelmed by the quality of work that the students have been producing.

Work setting week commencing 13th July

For the last week of term, we are introducing some “HT Challenge” activities which will be published on Class Charts on Monday 13th July. Each challenge activity will have a link which the students can click on. The link will take the students to a pre-recorded video of their teacher introducing the challenge task and an explanation of how to complete the task successfully. The students should aim to complete as many challenges as possible as this will contribute to the overall house competition, however, all students should complete a minimum of 3. Students should aim to pick option subjects that they would usually study in school.

Students will not receive feedback in the generic way but will be awarded a “challenge” achievement point on Class Charts which will be tracked by the relevant Assistant Principal. All evidence of completed challenges should be submitted to Class Charts using the blue upload button. The deadline for any entries will be 12:00 noon on the 17th July.

Virtual Sports Day

How is it going to work?

- The challenges will run over a week.
- There are 8 challenges. Students can do all or some of the challenges but remember, the more challenges you attempt the higher chance your House will win.
- It will go live on Class Charts on Monday 13th July.
- 1 entry per student using the activity challenge cards that will be on Class Charts in your form area.
- Once you have submitted your entry you cannot enter again, however you can enter the bonus round multiple times.
- Students can upload daily activity sheets plus photo evidence to their Form Tutor to collate.
- House colours are strongly encouraged.
- Daily totals will be collected by Form tutors and PE staff for up to date house totals per year group.
- Daily updates on House positions via Mrs Morgan.
- Final submissions by 12 noon on the last day for final standings at 3.00pm.
- Bonus Pet round – if you have a talented pet and want to earn some bonus points for your house you can upload a brief video clip to the PE twitter account: @HTurnford_PE
- Remember, leave your name out but tag your house to receive the points!
