Dear Year 13 students

A Level and L3 Vocational Results Day – Thursday 13th August

We hope that, despite the unusual circumstances surrounding this year's exam results, there will be much to celebrate and that students' hard work will be recognised.

Recently you completed a survey to select your preferred method for collecting results. Depending on the option that you selected the following processes will apply.

- 1. If you opted to have your results texted/emailed to you, then these will be sent to your **school email address only** with a password and link sent separately on how to open the results on the Thursday.
- 2. If your preferred method was to receive your results by post, then the results will be posted on Thursday to the home address that we hold for you on SIMS. Please note you will not receive your results until the Friday at the earliest.
- 3. If you selected the option to come in to school to collect your results, then you are able to do so between 8am and 11am on Thursday 13th August for A Levels and Level 3 vocational subjects. You will collect your results from the Sixth Form Centre and if it gets too busy, then you will be asked to queue outside until it is safe for you to come into the building in a socially distanced way. Please do not come to school in groups or gather in the car park. It will not be possible for sixth form students or parents to park on the school site if coming to collect results as our contractors are on site undertaking works in preparation for the construction of our new building. I suggest that you park in Nightleys car park. The day will be organised to ensure that we can maintain social distancing in line with government guidelines. Please ensure you keep 2 metres from others at all times, floor marking will help with this. When entering the Sixth Form Centre, please use the hand sanitisers provided. Please do not come to school if you have any symptoms of coronavirus, you've tested positive for coronavirus, you live with someone who has symptoms or has tested positive or you're told by NHS Test and Trace that you've been in contact with a person with coronavirus.

Please note that any results not collected by 11am on Thursday 13th August will be posted to your home address. You will not be able to come in and collect them at an alternative time. For security reasons results cannot be given out by telephone under any circumstances.

In order to support you with your future destinations, we will have YC Herts and My Big Career available remotely for apprenticeship and UCAS applications on Thursday 13th August.

Sixth form staff will also be able to guide you on the day should you require any support. I am conscious that this has been a difficult and anxious time for you as a result of the disruption caused by the coronavirus pandemic. How Have Grades Been Calculated?

Grades have been submitted to the exam boards based on a collation of evidence including external examinations (where appropriate), mock data, coursework, as well as internal assessments, classwork and intervention work. Teachers have also taken into consideration the gains that students make in the final months due to revision, Easter lessons, interventions and targeted work.

These grades are then collated by the exam boards and calculations are made across national data. The exam boards then issue final grades.

Entry to these exams will only be available to students in subjects for which they were entered in the Summer season. Students who are considering entering resits also need to be mindful of the strict entry deadline. All entries for resits must be received by Mr Walsh <u>walshb@haileyburyturnford.com</u> by the **27th August**. Late entries will not be possible and so any student who misses the deadline will lose the opportunity to sit the exams in the Autumn.
