## COVID-19 self-isolation and positive case reporting

Please contact the school before Monday by email at <u>attendance@haileyburyturnford.com</u> if during the half-term break your child who attends Haileybury Turnford:

- has experienced symptoms of COVID-19 (a high temperature; a new, continuous cough; a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)
- has been tested and had a positive result
- is self-isolating due to someone they live with in the same household (or support bubble) having COVID-19 symptoms or has received a positive test result
- has been told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace or the NHS COVID-19 app
- arrives in the UK from a country with a high coronavirus risk and are told to quarantine (see current government advice here: <a href="https://www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-travel-corridors">https://www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-travel-corridors</a>)

## A reminder: the school day

Thank you for your support last term with our staggered start and finish times to the school day. Please note that some Year 11 support sessions start from 8.00am and sixth formers are also able to arrive from 8.00am too. ## Traffic in Mill Lane and around school

Please be very careful if dropping off or picking up your child close to school. Our car park will remain closed at the start and end of the school day to all traffic (other than emergency services or where the disabled parking bays are required to be used). Students will be walking through the car park at these times as different year groups have different entry and exit gates to/from school.

## **Changes to the Sixth Form Bubble**

From Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> November, please note that sixth formers will be accompanied to lessons which take place outside of the Sixth Form Centre, and then accompanied back to the Sixth Form Centre by their teacher after each lesson. This is to avoid sixth formers having any contact with other year groups and maintaining the separation of all "bubbles" within the school. Further details will be communicated to sixth form students separately.

## Face coverings (masks)

These still remain optional for students whilst Hertfordshire's Local COVID Alert Level remains medium. Government guidance states that when an area moves to Local COVID Alert Level high or very high, in settings where students in Year 7 and above are educated, face coverings should be worn by adults and students when moving around the premises, outside of classrooms, such as in corridors and communal areas where social distancing cannot easily be maintained. We will be preparing students to be ready for this, in the event of new local restrictions being agreed which would require these new arrangements requiring the use of face coverings in certain circumstances. Please could I remind all families that students must continue to wear face coverings if they travel to school by public transport which has been the case since the start of term (unless exempt).
