What I will do after Sixth Form? I want to go to University to complete a degree in Psychology or Forensic Science.





Best thing about Sixth Form? Being able to work with friends during non-contact periods and the ability to leave school if I don't have any lessons.


Worst thing about Sixth Form? There are a limited amount of IT resources in the quiet study area.
