Back in 2018, following interim funding from the Gatsby Foundation, the Advanced Therapies Apprenticeship Community (ATAC) was established via the Cell and Gene Therapy Catapult, funded by Innovate UK, to develop the first apprenticeship programme designed specifically to train and upskill individuals to develop, manufacture and deliver innovative cell and gene therapies at scale. The community has flourished over the last three years, with over 130 apprentices from 37 companies on programme. The initial funding ends this year, but due to the success of the programme through industry engagement and uptake, we are delighted to announce that Innovate UK will continue to support with follow on funding.


