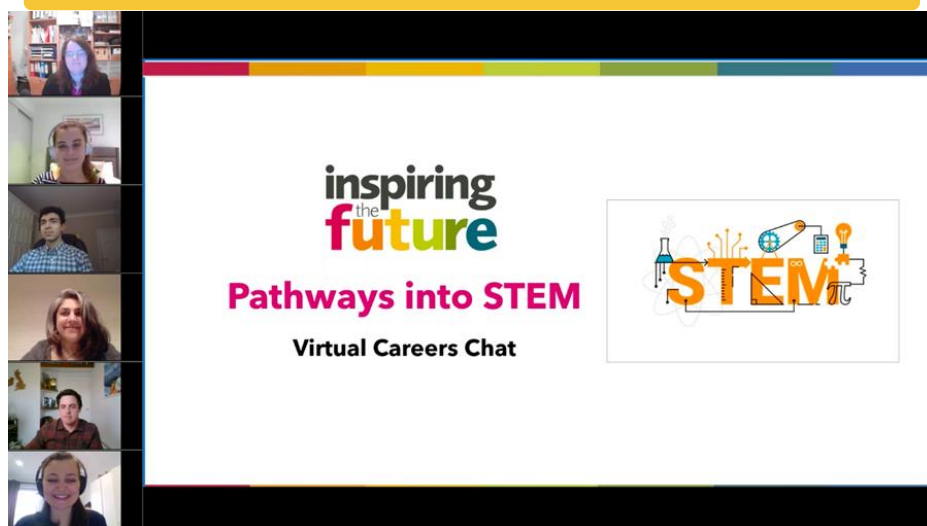
## Post 16 Pathways into STEM
