


In summer 2020, the Chancellor announced a new employer initiative aimed at creating six-month paid work placements for young people who are at risk of long-term unemployment due to the COVID-19 pandemic – the Kickstart Scheme.

The Kickstart Scheme covers England, Scotland, and Wales. For each Kickstart job, the government will cover 25 hours a week in addition to pension and National Insurance contributions. Employers will also receive placement wraparound support for the young person, including personal development and employability skills.

The scheme is currently due to run until December 2021 with the possibility of an extension beyond this date.

World Maths Day – Wednesday 5th May

The Year 13 Maths students were involved with a problem-solving task, on the use of Integration to find area under a curve and derive the formulae of cones, cylinders and spheres. The Year 7 students in the maths club also used the concept of ratios to investigate the value of Pi. They investigated different sized circular objects using strings and a rulers for measurement. The Year 11 students who will be taking A-level maths with us were also given a task on problem-solving with areas of sectors, the application of bearings and also finding the nth terms of sequences with cubes and quartics.

Stephen Lawrence Day 2021

Stephen Lawrence Day is named after the black teenager who was killed in a racist attack on the same day in 1993. Students were offered the opportunity to take part in three Stephen Lawrence Day challenges; doing an act of good

Ramadan Mubarak to all our staff, students and families who are fasting during the month of Ramadan.

Ramadan is the ninth month in the Islamic calendar. It is a 29-30-day period of prayer, fasting, self-control, charity giving and goodwill to others. Ramadan is a time of self-reflection, increased religious devotion and self-control over the need to eat and drink. Fasting during Ramadan is one of the Five Pillars or religious duties.



Ramadan started on 12th April and will end on 12th May, lasting for 30 days ending with an important festival; Eid al-Fitr.

Muslims will be expected to wake before sunrise, eat, drink and pray before the start of the day. Some of our students will be observing Ramadan and taking part in fasting. They will travel to school and be expected to take part in school activities, watch others eating and drinking and get on with their normal lives. They will then go home and eat at sunset to end the fast. This will continue for 30 days.

The HT community understand the importance of this obligatory pillar of Islam and supports all students and staff who observe it.

- Students will be learning about the importance information and significance of Ramadan and Eid al-Fitr for Muslims during Tutor time next week. Ramadan is a holy month and for many Muslims it can bring about a lifetime change.
- Saying 'Ramadan Mubarak' to our students to wish the recipient a blessed or generous Ramadan.
- Pastoral staff have been liaising closely with our parents and students to understand if there is any way we can support our students who are fasting.
