Dear Parent/Carer

As you are aware we have asked Year 10 students to stay at home and not attend school tomorrow, Tuesday 6th July. It is extremely important that we provide the students with a quality education through our remote learning platform Microsoft Teams.

The exception to working from home is for the Year 10 Child Development students who have an all-day session in school with Miss Ridgeway. This will go ahead as planned, and students should arrive in school for 8.55am.

Student expectations

- 1. Students are expected to attend all online lessons. This is non-negotiable and attendance will be tracked and monitored. If your child is unwell, please contact attendance@haileyburyturnford.com as per the normal procedure.
- 2. When students join the online lesson, they are expected to behave in an appropriate manner and adhere to the school's behaviour policy. Achievement points will still be awarded for excellent engagement and conduct.
- 3. All microphones and cameras should be switched off. All lessons will be recorded for safeguarding reasons.

Timetable for the day

- 1. Students will receive invites from their teachers for each lesson. This will be sent through their school email and they should accept all lesson invites.
- 2. Students will then log into Microsoft Teams and join the lesson using their calendar.
- 3. Lessons will begin 15 minutes later than usual so please check the timetable below carefully.
- 4. Students should review and consolidate their learning in the time at the end of each remote lesson, prior to the following lesson starting, and following Period 5.

How do I log into Microsoft Teams?

- Go to the school website www.haileyburyturnford.com
- Go to the student portal on the school's webpage and click "Teams".
- Here they will be asked to log-in using their school username and password. This is the same details as they
 would use in school.
