

HAILEYBURY TURNFORD: 16 to 19 TUTION FUND 2020-21

The 16-19 tuition fund is one-off funding for the 2020/21 academic year to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from COVID-19. Our share of this funding is £7382.

In line with Government guidance we have prioritised the following groups of 16-19-year old students for support from the fund:

- Students who have not achieved a grade 4 in either GCSE maths or English
- Students with SEND (special educational needs and disabilities)
- Students classified as disadvantaged
- Students who have achieved a grade 4 but also would benefit from catch up support due to disrupted learning
- Students who require support for their current Level 3 studies, where learning has been disrupted.

We have used the fund as follows:

- Purchasing bespoke resources for the targeted students and use these to support their learning
- Running additional small group classes or one-to-one sessions for these students during the school day.
