

## Attendance and punctuality to school – we need your support

Aim for at least 96% attendance

100% Attendance	0 weeks of missed learning
95% Attendance	1 week and 4 days of missed learning
90% Attendance	3 weeks and 4 days of missed learning
85% Attendance	5 weeks and 3 days of missed learning
80% Attendance	7 weeks and 3 days of missed learning
70% Attendance	9 weeks and 1 days of missed learning



### The Importance of Reading

- Reading supports every aspect of the curriculum
- Reading will make the biggest different to your child's success at HT
- Read at home with your child and encourage a culture of reading
- Put subtitles onto the TV this makes a huge difference


#### **Class Charts**


#### What do we use Class Charts for?

- Teachers award positive achievements everyday
- Teachers award behaviour points/conduct points
- Teachers use the system to inform parents of paybacks (detentions)
- The system will alert you when your child has gained an award
- All homework is set via Class Charts and parents can track completed and incomplete homework tasks














What does ClassCharts look like?
