Our students were shown first hand how Maths directly links to the real world and how it supports specific areas of a range of jobs. Finally, we had Keeley Collins come into our Year 10 Child Development class to talk through stages of labour and the importance of antenatal classes, students were receptive, thank you for coming in.


