<u>Revision – flash cards</u> 'Just reading' isn't effective. Avoid passive activities like highlighting or copying. How to test yourself:

- 1. Tackle example questions from memory
- 2. Then check and improve answers using revision guide / book
  - 3. Cover and reproduce from memory
- 4. Test yourself using flash cards or visual maps

Revision timetable Create a timetable of subjects to revise and spread out into 30minute chunks. This helps you prioritise and stick to your revision.

Research suggests that planning your revision makes your productivity more effective. It also improves independent learning and is one of the main key to success at GCSE!
