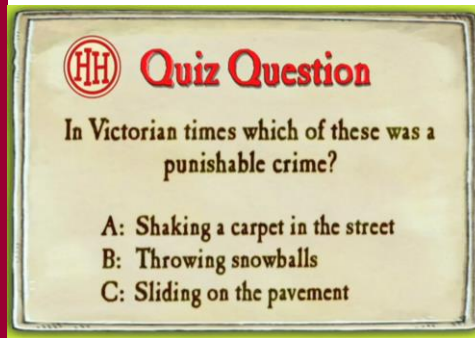
I hope you and your families are well. Well done for all of your hard work and commitment to your studies this term.

### Revision – mind map

1. Create a Central Idea
2. Add branches to your map
3. Add keywords
4. Color code your branches
5. Include visual signifiers (e.g. images)



### Revision timetable

Create a timetable of subjects to revise and spread out into 30-minute chunks. This helps you prioritise and stick to your revision.

Research suggests that planning your revision makes your productivity more effective. It also improves independent learning and is one of the main key to success at GCSE!

### Revision – flash cards

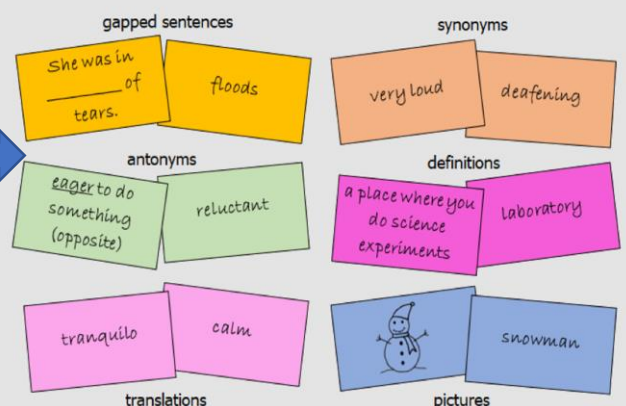
‘Just reading’ isn’t effective.

Avoid passive activities like highlighting or copying.

How to test yourself:

1. Tackle example questions from memory
2. Then check and improve answers using revision guide / book
3. Cover and reproduce from memory
4. Test yourself using flash cards or visual maps
