GCSE Results Day - Thursday 25th August

Results can be collected from the Quad area between 8.30am – 10.00am. We ask that parents wait outside the green gates in the school car park whilst our Year 11 students collect their results. They will then come out to share their results with you!

Ms Johnson, the Sixth Form team, Luisa Grandine, who is a Personal Adviser from Services for Young People and other members of the Senior Leadership Team will be on site to support with decisions regarding results, applications, and next steps; and students will be supported through subject choices for Haileybury Turnford Sixth Form.

Please note:

- 1. All Science Knowledge Organisers will need to be returned to the school. They should be brought back into school by **Friday 8th July** so we can use them with other students before we break for the summer holiday.
- 2. Any unwanted revision guides, calculators or school uniform including PE kit can be returned or donated to the school on Results Day, and we will use such items with future students.
- 3. Any borrowed school laptops should be returned before the end of term or on Results Day at the very latest.
- 4. We will be asking students to tell us their plans for September and taking contact details from those leaving us. This is to track student future destinations, as we wish to monitor the future destinations of all HT students, as well as being required to report destinations to the Local Authority.

Those of you who are planning on attending HT Sixth Form will need to be available for our Induction Days on **Wednesday 29th June & Thursday 30th June next week**. This is a valuable moment to re-engage and bridge the learning between VTQs, GCSEs and A Levels.
