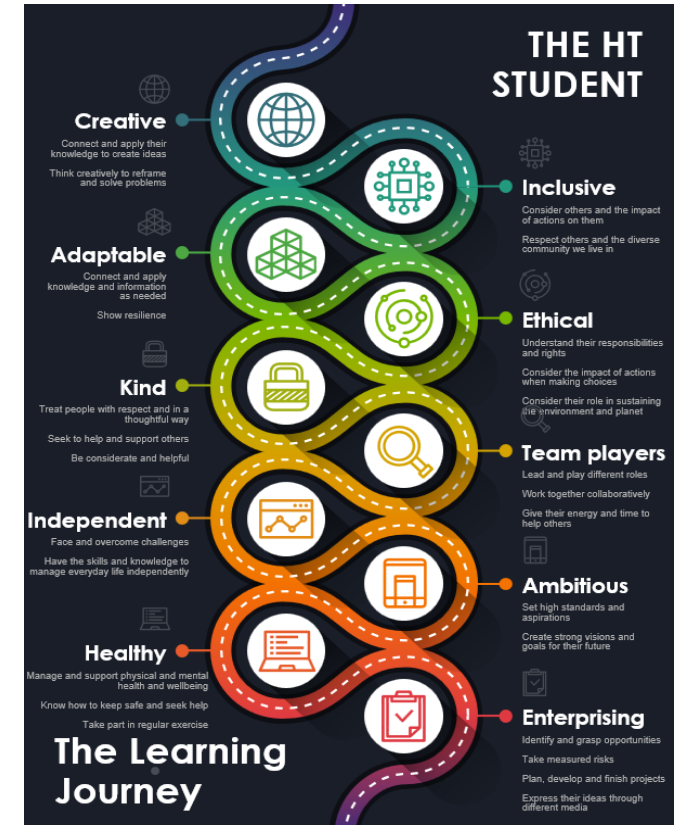
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# Preparing our students for their future

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# Ready for learning: Attendance

Good attendance and  
punctuality  
improves chances of success

- Good attendance and punctuality are essential if your child is to achieve their full potential, both academically and socially.
- **Students must arrive before 8.35am**
- **The main school gates will be locked at 8.35am**
- **If a student arrives after 8.35am they will be marked as being late and will be issued with a late payback (detention)**
- **Registration starts at 8.40am**

<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Yellow Card</b>	Removal from classroom into another classroom. Payback at break/lunch Resolve meeting Form Tutor discussion	<b>2</b> behaviour points
<b>Red Card</b>	Serious breach of the behaviour code. Removal from the classroom. Parents informed	<b>6</b> behaviour points

  - Link Worker support



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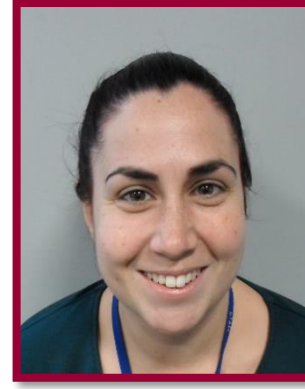

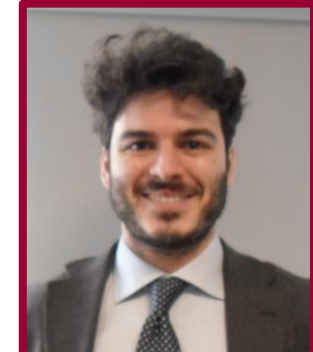
