A very warm welcome to the new school year. I hope all families had a really enjoyable summer and our students are looking forward to the academic year ahead. It has certainly been a very positive start to the year in school this week, and it has been excellent to welcome our students back to their learning following the summer break.

We start this academic year will much positivity, following an excellent year for the school in 2021/22 in which Ofsted rated us as a Good School. We finished the year with very strong Year 11 and Year 13 exam results for our students, and importantly, our students have moved onto destinations of their choice either in our sixth form, at college, work or university.
