Reminders and Expectations from our students in Y7-11 from Monday 7th November

We continue to be impressed by most of our students who arrive to school on time and before 8.35am looking smart in the correct uniform. After the half-term break, we will continue to expect every student to come to school wearing correct full uniform, including school shoes (black, polishable school shoes – please see the uniform policy for further guidance) and can be found [here](#).

As a reminder of our school uniform expectations, students with pierced ears may wear one set of small studs in the lower lobe of each ear. Nose studs and other facial or body piercings are not allowed. Extreme dyed hair colours and styles are not permitted, nail varnish, acrylic or gel nails are not permitted. Students are not permitted to wear false eyelashes. Students will be asked to remove any inappropriate items of jewellery, make-up or nail varnish/acrylics and will receive a conduct point which will be added to their Class Charts account. (Six conduct card signatures will result in a one hour after school payback).

Most students arrive to school on time without fail, every day. Students are expected to arrive at school by 8.35am. The school gates close at 8.35am and any student who arrives after this time will receive a late mark and a 30 minute after school payback (detention). Parents and carers will be notified if your child is late to school or late to a lesson. Please continue to support your child to arrive to school on time. As a reminder our breakfast club is available from 7.45am every day for students who wish to buy a hot breakfast and drink before school. Being on time to school is important. Students who are repeatedly late to school miss important messages given in assembly or Tutor time and can feel less connected to other students and the school as a result.

Thank you for your support in reminding students to wear their student lanyard and ID card every day to school. If your child does lose their lanyard and or ID card you are able to purchase a new card and lanyard via ParentPay the link can be accessed [here](#).
