### **Half Term Revision Tips**

- Check Class Charts for work set by your teachers
- Aim for around 3 hours a day
- Plan your revision and make a revision timetable
- Cover all subjects, don't just focus on one
- Make sure you take breaks





Mock Exams are due to start the first week in December.

Mocks should be taken seriously and prepared well for; this gives us the best indication of where students are and how we can help them. If students do not prepare well then it is not a true representation of where they are at and teachers may plan for gaps that are not needed to focus on.

Some key ways to be successful in mocks: attendance at school and interventions, revision outside of school hours on all your subjects, being organised and working during October half term – do not lose the momentum you have worked so hard to build!

### Stats do not lie.

- If you have above 95% attendance, on average you will achieve nearly half a grade higher in every one of your subjects than your target grade
- If you have between 90%-95% attendance, on average you will achieve over half a grade lower in every one of your subjects than your target grade.
- If you have below 90% attendance, on average you will achieve over 1.5 grades lower than your target grade in every one of your subjects.


A regular sight from 8am in the Year 11 corridor this year. Extra revision and focus are vital this year and the vast majority of students are taking this very seriously, well done!
