Oxford's UNIQ summer school programme is now accepting applications, and is a marvellous opportunity to partake in.

UNIQ is a FREE Spring/Summer school at Oxford University. UNIQ is open to Year 12 (or equivalent) students studying at UK state schools/colleges. Students apply for a specific course that aims to give them a realistic view of Oxford student life. UNIQ participants live in an Oxford college during the Spring/ Summer School. They attend lectures and seminars in their chosen subject, and workshops about applying to Oxford. Participants can also take part in a variety of social activities each evening. Also, they cover the cost of transport from your nearest town, your food and accommodation, social activities and the academic sessions.

As UNIQ is an access programme, preference is given to applicants from low socio-economic status backgrounds and/or from areas with low progression to higher education. Therefore, an unsuccessful application to UNIQ does not reflect an applicant's likelihood of being successful in an application for undergraduate study at the University of Oxford.
