A message from Mrs Goodes

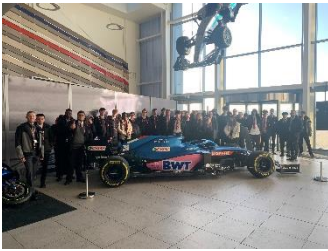
