National Education Union (NEU) strike on Wednesday 1st February

This letter is to inform you about our plans for Wednesday 1st February in response to the planned National Education Union (NEU) strike action.

Following an assessment of staff numbers at Haileybury Turnford, the school will be closed to all students on Wednesday 1st February, with the exception of Year 12 and Year 13 students, identified vulnerable students and students who are taking Public or Internal Mock Examinations. Therefore, the plan for Wednesday 1st February is as follows:

- Students in **Year 7-11** will be set online learning on Class Charts to complete at home.
- **Y11** External Public Examination for IT (Effective Digital Working Practices) will continue as planned and this will take place at school.
- **Year 12 and 13** students will attend school and their timetabled lessons as planned (where the normal timetabled teacher is available to teach the lesson).
- **Year 13** students' Internal Mock Examinations will continue to take place at school as planned.
- Identified **vulnerable students** will be supported with their learning in school. Identified students' parents/carers will be contacted by a member of our pastoral team.
- Co-curricular and any planned after school activities will not take place on 1.02.23.
- If your child receives Free School Meals you will be sent details of how you can request a pre-ordered packed lunch for your child.

Further details of the plans above will be distributed by relevant staff members, next week.

We appreciate the planned strike will cause disruption for many of our families and we have endeavoured to provide support to those students who are taking examinations and students who may be particularly vulnerable.
