Stats do not lie.

- If you have above 95% attendance, on average you will achieve nearly half a grade higher in every one of your subjects than your target grade
- If you have between 90%-95% attendance, on average you will achieve over half a grade
 lower in every one of your subjects than your target grade.
- If you have below 90% attendance, on average you will achieve over 1.5 grades lower than your target grade in every one of your subjects.



Revision Tips for Success



- 1. Get a revision timetable plan your half term holidays effectively, giving yourself structured time for revision and incorporating breaks.
- 2. Don't worry about how it looks your notes don't need to be pretty, make sure you get the key details down.
