End of Spring Term Arrangements

Please find below an outline of our plans for the end of the school term and Year on Thursday 6th April.

We plan to have a normal school day and lessons up until 12.30pm with an extended break time by 5 minutes. Students will be **dismissed from their lesson at 12.30pm**.

We will expect all students to return home, promptly.

As we are entering the final term of the Year we wanted to remind all parents/carers about the importance of our expectations with school uniform. We insist on school uniform for two reasons: it identifies students as belonging to, and being a part of our school community, and makes it easier for parents/carers to ensure your child is suitably dressed.

We expect all students to arrive to school on time and **before 8.35am** and to be wearing the correct school uniform, including correct school shoes. Our school uniform policy found [here](#), clearly outlines our expectations around school uniform and expectations about jewellery, hairstyles and nails. More of our girls are opting to wear black school trousers as a practical and smart alternative to wearing a kilt. Please could you ensure the black trousers are suitable and as stated in our uniform policy. Please may we ask all parents/carers to support our expectations and ensure our students are wearing their uniform correctly and adhering to our expectations.
